



Welcome to the 2024 DBC Inc. Winter Senior Social Roster

The 2024 winter senior social roster will commence on Monday 12th February and run for 14 weeks until 27th May then 3 weeks of finals concluding on the 24th June 2024.

Games will not be played on the following dates –

- Monday 11th March – March Long Weekend
- Monday 1st April – Easter Monday
- Monday 10th June – June Long Weekend

REGISTRATION FEES

Basketball Tasmania have increased their registration fee for the first time in 6 years from \$60.00 to \$70.00. This increase comes about to cover the increasing demand for BTas services and support and increased costs across all areas of the BTas operation.

In addition, Basketball Australia have introduced a Game Development Levy of \$5.61, this is an annual fee. Levy is being implemented by BA to support growth and development of basketball at all levels of the game and to enhance opportunities for the sport.

PlayHQ will now give participants the choice to pay fees in instalments using "PayPal Pay in 4" option.

Registration fees are made up of the following components:

Basketball Tasmania Fee - 12 month fee of \$70-00 - compulsory state registration also includes insurance in the unlikely event of an injury.

NWBU Inc. Fee - 12 month fee of \$11-00 or 6 month fee of \$5.50 – compulsory fee to play in any competition on the NW Coast.

Basketball Australia levy – 12 month fee of \$5.61 – compulsory levy set by BA.

DBC Inc. Fee \$40-00 – club registration to Devonport Basketball Council Inc to participate in the winter roster.

Players will be required to register with your home club prior to registering with Devonport. As your Basketball Tasmania and NWBU fees will already have been paid you will only be required to pay the DBC Inc. registration fee of \$40-00. Do not register as a new member instead use your existing member profile.

All teams will be given a unique registration link which has been issued to your team contact.

WEEKLY DOOR FEES

After consulting with numerous players and parents (junior roster) the club has taken the decision to include the weekly playing/door fees in the registration process.

- player inconvenience of find \$5 cash each week
- eliminate cash handling (collecting, counting, banking)
- reduce drain on (limited) volunteers; eliminate door keepers

BASKETBALL CLUB

The upfront playing fee will be \$75.00 based on 14 roster games plus at least 1 finals game TOTAL of at least 15 games @ \$5.00 per game. This will be in addition to the normal registration fees (Basketball Tasmania, NWBU, Basketball Australia, DBC).

Should this new arrangement cause hardship or stop you from playing please contact us to come to alternative arrangement, as the last thing we want to do is stop anyone from participating. There is no increase in cost just an upfront payment of the playing fees.

A significant part of the registration goes to Basketball Tasmania \$70.00, NWBU \$11.00 and now Basketball Australia game development fee \$5.61.

Please note the club has not increased registration or door fees for several years now although we have seen increased costs in running the roster and keeping the club operating.

PlayHQ – After you have put in your unique team code there will be 6 steps to follow.

CHOOSE USER – Who is registering or new user

CHOOSE ROLE – Player

PARTICIPANT DETAILS – Ensure details are correct or add details for a new player

FEES - BTas, BA, NWBU and DBC registration fees will be shown

PRODUCT – Door fees (update order and continue)

PAYMENT & SUMMARY – Payment option (if required you can use the Pay Pal Pay in 4)

If a division has an uneven number of teams and a bye/s occurs, then the DBC will reimburse players for the number of byes.

If a team forfeits, players of that team will not be reimbursed the game fee however the opposing team will be reimbursed.

A player who has played in previous rosters and works away can apply for a reduction of door fees by contacting the DBC Office on 64242440 prior to registering.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL PLAYERS READ THE FOLLOWING:-

- Be respectful to all umpires, one warning and then player will be asked to leave the venue.
- Players must be registered prior to taking the court. If you are not on the iPad on game night, then you will not be allowed to play.
- Teams can only use the same fill in player for a maximum of 2 games during the roster.
- Players can only be used as a fill in for one game each week.
- If a team forfeits twice, they will be eliminated from the roster.
- Nominated team referee – Teams **MUST** supply a referee who will only receive payment if they are competent in assisting the DBC referee.
- Duty teams – will lose 2 points for not having 2 on the bench and/or 2 points for not supplying an umpire.
- All team members to ensure that they have the same colour tops with numbers on the front and back.
